Personal data that we process

Growingpaper processes your personal data by using our services and / or by providing this information to us. Below is an overview of the personal data we process:

- First and last name
- Address data
- Phone number
- E-mail address
- IBAN

Growingpaper processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Phone or e-mail if necessary to carry out our services
- Inform you about changes to our services and products
- To deliver goods and services to you
- Invoicing

Automated decision-making

Growingpaper does not make decisions based on automated processing on matters that can have (significant) consequences for people. These are decisions that are taken by computer programs or systems, without involving a person (for example, a Growingpaper employee).

How long we store personal data

Growingpaper does not store your personal data longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the goals for which your data is collected.

Sharing personal data with third parties

Growingpaper will not sell your information to third parties and will only provide this information if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. With companies that process your data in our order, we conclude a processor and / or processor agreement to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. Growingpaper remains responsible for these processing operations.

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

Growingpaper uses functional, analytical and tracking cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored in the browser of your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. Growingpaper uses cookies with a purely technical functionality. These ensure that the website works properly and that, for example, your preferred settings are remembered. These cookies are also used to make the website work well and to optimize it. In addition, we place cookies that keep track of your browsing habits so that we can offer customized content and advertisements. On your first visit to our website we have already informed you about these cookies and we have asked you for permission to place them. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it does not store cookies anymore. In addition, you can also delete all information previously saved via the settings of your browser.

Cookies are also placed on this website by third parties. These are for example advertisers and / or the social media companies Google Analytics and Facebook.

View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. You also have the right to withdraw your consent to the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Growingpaper and you have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal information we hold to you or another organization mentioned by you in a computer file. You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for cancellation of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to ton@growingpaper.com. To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your ID with the request. Make your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Citizen Service Number (BSN) black in this copy. This is to protect your privacy. We respond as quickly as possible, but within four weeks, at your request. Growingpaper also wants to point out that you have the opportunity to file a complaint with the national supervisory authority, the Dutch Data Protection Authority.
